Defects as pointed out by the office are ignored.

This is a case of misuse of the privilege of bail. The petitioner was granted bail in connection with Sisai P.S. Case No. 15/1992 but subsequently due to non-appearance his bail bond was cancelled on 21.03.2005 and on 30.05.2006 he was declared an absconder. The petitioner has been taken into custody on 31.08.2021.

It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the co-accused has already been acquitted by the learned trial court.

On consideration of the aforesaid facts, the petitioner, named above, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge-I, Gumla in connection with Sisai P.S. Case No. 15/1992, corresponding to G.R. No. 97/1992 (Spt. S.T. No. 220/2002), subject to the condition that the petitioner shall remain physically present before the learned trial court on each and every date till the conclusion of the trial.
