This Criminal Misc. Bail Application has been brought under Section 439 of Cr.P.C., seeking regular bail in connection with FIR No.203/2020 registered at Police Station, Malvia Nagar, Jaipur, for offences under Sections 420, 120-B of IPC and Sections 63, 65 of the Copy Right Act.

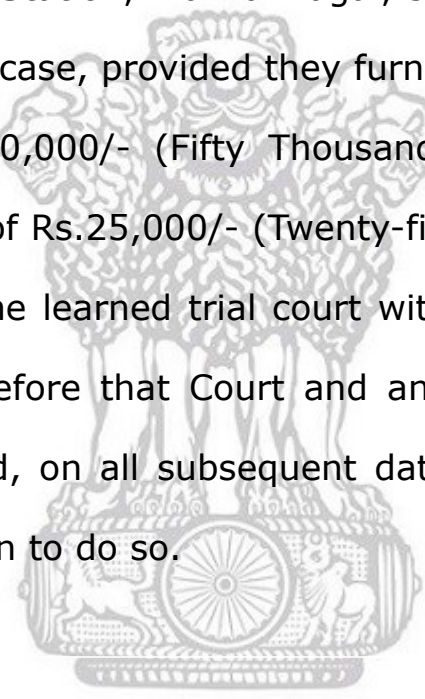
Heard learned counsel for the petitioner through Video Conferencing.

It has been argued on behalf of the petitioner that they have been falsely implicated in this case. Petitioners are driver and cleaner of the vehicle from which recovery of *bidis* bearing false trade mark were alleged to have been made. The matter is pending under Sections 420, 120-B IPC and 63/65 Copy Right Act

which is triable by Magistrate Court and completion of the trial will take time. There are no criminal antecedents of the petitioners.

Taking into consideration the submissions put forth and overall facts and circumstances of the case, but without commenting upon detailed merits of the case, this Court deems it fit to enlarge the accused on bail.

Therefore, the bail application is allowed. Accused-petitioner **Naved Khan S/o Shri Shahzada and Mohammad Yusuf S/o Mohammad Yunus** shall be released on bail in FIR No.203/2020 registered at Police Station, Malvia Nagar, Jaipur, if they are not wanted in any other case, provided they furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- (Fifty Thousand) together with two sureties in the sum of Rs.25,000/- (Twenty-five Thousand) each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court with the stipulation that they shall appear before that Court and any court to which the matter is transferred, on all subsequent dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so.
