ORDER:

In this writ petition, the petitioner questions the action of the respondents in not considering her case for absorption as Superintendent in the first respondent institute and seeks a consequential direction to the respondents to consider her case for appointment as the Superintendent in the first respondent institute at Vijayawada balabhavan and to pay her revised pay scales in accordance with G.O.Ms. No. 200 dated 05.03.1982.

Sri A. Veeraswamy, learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents, would place reliance on the counter affidavits filed by the 1st respondent and respondents 2 and 5, to contend that the 1st respondent has no connection whatsoever with Jawahar balabhavan which is run by the Ministry of Education of the State Government.

Learned Counsel would submit that employees working in Nagarjuna Sagar had formed a society and had established the 1st respondent-Bal Bhavan to cater the needs of their children. Learned Counsel would state that, since the 1st respondent is not under the control of respondents 2 to 5 nor does it have any

connection with Jawahar Balabhavan, G.O.Ms. No. 200 dated 05.03.1982 which relates to the scheme for setting up of District Jawahar Bal Bhavans and Jawahar Bal Kendras has no application to the 1st respondent society. Since the 1st respondent is admittedly neither a District Jawahar Bal Bhavan nor a Jawahar Bal Kendra no right accrues in the petitioner's favour to claim absorption as a Superintendent placing reliance on G.O.Ms. No. 200 dated 05.03.1982 or for payment of the regular scales of pay applicable to Superintendents in the Jawahar Bal Bhavans and Jawahar Bal Kendras. The writ petition is misconceived and is accordingly dismissed. No costs.
