**ORDER:**

This writ petition is filed for the following substantive relief:

“to issue an appropriate Writ, order or direction more particularly in the nature of Writ of MANDAMUS declaring the action of the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent in issuing the Proceedings No.MD/APSTEP/A1/97 dated:27.9.1998 in so far as it relates to the petitioner and declare to the extent that the order posting the petitioner as Jr.Assistant, Society for Training and Employment Promotion, Adilabad is illegal and consequently direct the respondents to post the petitioner at Warangal as Jr.Assistant, STEP, Warangal and pass such other order or orders.”
