ORAL JUDGEMENT

RULE.

Heard the learned Advocates for the parties. It is agreed between the parties that the petitioner-Management shall permit the respondent No.1 to resume the duties in pusuance of the order of the Tribunal. However, she will be paid only 40% of the

backwages. The petitioner management also agrees that they will withdraw the departmental enquiry pending against her. In view of the agreement order between the parties, order of the Tribunal dated 13.10.1997 is modified to the extent that the respondent-Rajeshwariben S Gajjar shall be paid 40% of the backwages. This Special Civil Application stands disposed of in terms of the agreement as stated above. Rule made absolute to the aforesaid extent.
