dismissed as not pressed.

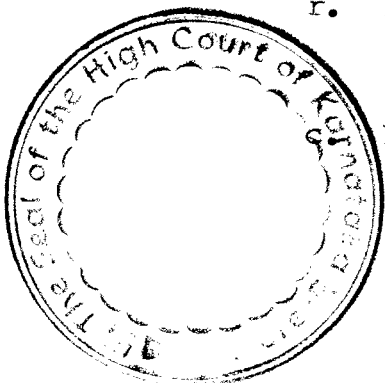
