Heard both Counsel. The petitioners-plaintiffs have challenged the order dated 24.2.1998 passed by the learned I Addl. Civil Judge (Jr.Divn), Tharwad allowing I.A.No.27 filed u/o 16 R.17 C.P.C. by the second defendant in 0.S.No.806/1989.
