ORAL JUDGEMENT

1. The petitioner is a detenue who was detained by an order of District Magistrate dated 4th March 1999 in exercise of powers u/s 3[1] of the Gujarat Prevention of Anti Social Activities Act, 1985. He has approached this Court with a petition challenging the grounds of detention on various counts.

2. When the matter was called out, Mr. Patel,

learned AGP appearing for the respondents states upon instructions and after perusing the file that the order of detention impugned in this petition came to be revoked by the State Government on 20th April 1999.
