ORDER

This writ petition is filed seeking a Mandamus to declare the action of the respondent in not considering the application of the petitioner for the post of Assistant Engineer Electrical (AEE) as per the notification dated 21.4.2006 as arbitrary and illegal.

While admitting the writ petition, the respondent was directed to issue hall ticket to the petitioner and permit her to appear for the examination to be held on 25.6.2006. The respondent was further directed not to declare the result of the petitioner until further orders.

Now, another WPMP is filed seeking a direction to the respondent to allow the petitioner to attend the interview in case she is qualified in the written test pending disposal of the writ petition.

There is no necessity to go into all the details.

A detailed counter-affidavit has been filed on behalf of the respondent, denying the allegations made by the petitioner. At para 6, it is asserted that the petitioner was issued with hall ticket and accordingly, she appeared for the written examination on 25.6.2006 and her result was

withheld. Further, the petitioner secured only 32 marks in the written test and cut off marks in the category of SC women is 56. Therefore, the case of the petitioner cannot be considered for selection.

In view of the averments made in the counter affidavit, nothing survives for further adjudication in this writ petition and the same is liable to be dismissed.

Writ petition is accordingly, dismissed. No costs.
