ORAL JUDGEMENT

The petitioner -Parvatiben Premabhai Durlabhbbhai
filed this petition through her power of attorney holder
Trikamlal Vasanji Balsara. When the advocate for the
petitioner Shri Arvind K.Shah expired, notice was issued
and when it was sought to be served on the power of

attorney holder, he said that the petitioner Parvatiben Premabhai Durlabhbhai had expired seven years ago in Pune, and the power of attorney was no longer in force.
