It appears that the entire process of selection and grant of licence has been unduly delayed. Such selection is made by the Dealer Selection Board. It is found that though an application to implead the Union of India was made in the past, no order of impleadment has been passed. Fortunately Shri A.S.Gaharwar, learned Sr. Central Government Standing Counsel is present today.
