The State through Shri U.P. Singh, Law Officer, Central Jail, Raipur, has filed the return inter-alia pleading that in accordance with the circular dated 10/8/1998, the convict is not entitled to remission but has to undergo the complete sentence. It is also submitted by the State that on an earlier occasion the petitioner himself had sent a letter to Hon'ble the Chief Justice of India and on the said letter W.P. No. 2112/2000 was registered in the High Court of Madhya Pradesh and after considering the merits of the matter, the High Court was pleased to dismiss the petition on 26/4/2000. The State has further submitted that after preparing the case, the Jail Authorities have submitted the matter to the Principal Secretary, Law Department, Chhattisgarh for its due consideration and the matter is likely to be disposed of at the State level within two months.</p> <p>Shri Ranvir Singh, learned GA submits that the State would take into consideration the rules, circulars and regula-</p>
