	<p>31.10.2001</p> <p>Mr. Prashant Jaiswal learned counsel for the petitioners.</p> <p>Mr. Deep Kesharwani learned counsel for the respondent no.1.</p> <p>Respondent no.2 has filed an affidavit. Shri Kesharwani prays for further time to obtain instructions. Respondent no.2 in his affidavit states that no fund has been received from the State government and that as soon as the Block Education Officer receives the allotment from the State government, the payments will be made. The petitioners are Gurujis who are entitled to receive honorarium as per the scheme. It is about one year since the Gurujis have not been paid. I can not understand how the Gurujis will serve faithfully if they are not paid their honorarium and that too for such a long time. No return also has been filed on behalf of the respondent no.1. In my view this petition should not be kept pending any longer. I would dispose of this writ petition as follows :-</p> <p>Respondent no.1 shall release fund to the Block Education Officer who in turn shall release the payments to Gurujis, the present petitioners immediately on receipt of such funds. Respondent no.1 shall make necessary funds available at the earliest and at any rate not later than 12.11.2001.</p> <p>The petition is accordingly disposed of.</p> <p>Certified copy as per rules.</p> <p>J</p>	<p>Sd/- Chief Justice</p>
