

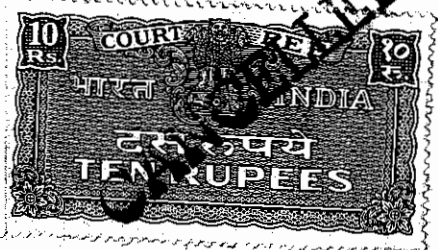

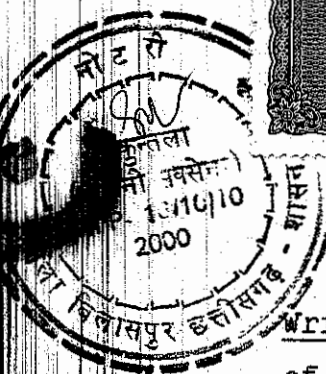

Agarwal, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Ranvir Singh, learned GA for respondents nos. 1, 2 and 3.</p> <p>The petitioner is officiating Sarpanch of Gram Panchayat Dongridih, Tahsil Baloda Bazar. Being aggrieved by the order passed by the learned Sub-Divisional Officer (Revenue), Baloda Bazar, an appeal was preferred before the learned Additional Collector, Baloda Bazar and the appeal is pending disposal before the learned Additional Collector.</p> <p>An application was made by the petitioner for stay of the impugned order issued by the learned Sub-Divisional Officer on 4/4/2001 (Annexure P/1). However, by order dated 19/4/2001 (Annexure P/4), the learned Additional Collector was pleased to reject the prayer for stay of the impugned order. Since the appeal has already been admitted, Mr. Sanjay K.
