ORDER

The following order of the Court was passed by R.S.Garg, J.-

For the reasons stated in the order passed by us today in W.P.No.6117/2000, the reliefs granted in favour of the recruit/respondent are modified to the following extent:

- (a) The recruit/respondent no.1 shall be taken back into sercice;
- (b) Looking to his long break in serwice, the matter for grant of back wages shall be within the discretion of the petitioners who shall decide the same in accordance with rules;
- back in service shall be given training for a period of six months in accordance with Rule 37 and on expiry of the said period he shall be required to pass the test to be held by the authority in accordance with Rule 36. If this time the recruit fails in passing the test or in showing that he has attained the required proficiency in the subject the Commandant shall be entitled to pass orders in accordance with Rule 37 and discharge the recruit from service.

The petition is disposed of with the afcresaid directions. In the circumstances of the case parties shall bear their own costs.
