	<p><b><u>28.11.2001</u></b></p> <p>Heard Shri Prashant Mishra, learned counsel for the petitioner.</p> <p>Heard also Shri V.R.Tiwari, learned counsel for the respondent No.1.</p> <p>It is stated by Shri V.R.Tiwari that this matter may be disposed of in terms of some orders passed by M.P. High Court in similar matters. The order impugned is at Annexure P-1 dated 25.06.2001 by which recovery is ordered. The matter relates to loss of food grains in the godowns. It is contended that before the order of recovery was issued no enquiry was carried out. It appears <del>proper</del> that enquiry should be made and only if the petitioners are found guilty then recovery should be made to make good the loss of the food grains, which were in their custody. The document Annexure P-18 is a letter addressed to the M.P. Government by the Chhattisgarh Government to the effect that the Chhattisgarh Civil Supplies Corporation has now come into existence.</p>

	<p>In view of this, Shri Prashant Mishra submits that appropriate authority to make enquiry is Civil Supplies Corporation, Government of Chhattisgarh. It appears, in view of the changed situation, this submission can be accepted.</p> <p>In the result, this petition is disposed of with a direction that the competent authority of Civil Supplies Corporation of the Government of Chhattisgarh make necessary enquiry and if petitioners are found guilty of the charges, order of recovery shall be made. Until such finding is arrived at and necessary orders are passed, recovery shall remain stayed. The petitioners shall be allowed to urge all the grounds that have been taken in the writ petition.
