Heard Shri Manoj Paranjape, learned counsel for the petitioner.

The matter relates to distributorship of petrol pump in Durg area to be given in favour of freedom fighters. representation has been pending before the competent authority for some time. Annexure A-4 is one such representation pending before the respondent No.1. It appears once representation is received it is incumbent upon the competent authority to proceed to examine on merit and dispose of the same expeditiously. In this view of the matter instead of issuing notices I propose to dispose of this petition as follows:-

Let the respondent No.1 examine the representation of the writ petitioner vide Annexure A-4 and pass necessary orders. Let the writ petitioner submit a fresh copy of the representation before the competent authority together with a copy of this order within seven days from today. On receipt of such representation, the competent authority shall examine and pass necessary orders. Until final orders are passed by way of disposal of the representation, no order of allotment of petrol pump to any other person shall be issued.
