ORDER

Shri Deeep Kesharwani, learned PL for the State.

The husband of the petitioner no.1, father of petitioners nos. 2,3 and 4 died on 8/3/1999 in harness while serving as Block Education Officer. Thereafter the petitionner no.1 submitted the petition to Collector for giving employment on compassionate ground. No action has been taken till date. Petitioners nos. 2,3 and 4 are minor children of late Ashok Kumar Sharma - deceased Government servant. It is contended that the petitioners are facing great economic hard-ship in the absence of any earning member in the family after the death of the said Government servant. Such matter should be dealt with expeditiously so that the sufferings of the members of the deceased Government servant are deliviated without loss of time.

On perusal of the various documents filed in the present case and after hearing Shri R.N. Jha, learned counsel for the petitionersas well as Shri Deep Kesharwani, learned PL for the respondent/State, I propose to dispose of

this petition as follows:

- 1) The Collector, Dantewada shall proceed to examine and d_spose of this petition for compassionate appointment expeditiously and at any rate not later than one month from the date of receipt of this order;
- 2) The petitioner may submit a fresh petition together with copy of this order to the Collector within 15 days from today.

Shri R.N. Jha, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioner no.1 may be given opportunity to serve some-where nearer Jagdalpur in view of difficult situation in Dantewada inasmuch as she has to look after three minor children. It is for the Competent Authority to take this fact into consideration while examining the representation of the petitioners.

As regards the claim for payment of Rs.83,136/it appears it would be difficult for this Court to exact ne
this aspect of the matter in exercise of jurisdiction
Article 226 of the Constitution of India. Let the writ
petitioners seek remedy before appropriate Court of jurisdiction.

With the above observations and directions, this petition is disposed of.
