Shrivastava learned counsel for the petitioner.</p> <p>Shri Gautam Bhaduri, P.L., for the State.</p> <p>Heard.</p> <p>The petitioner while working at Durg was transferred to Balod. He is said to be a handicapped person. There is a certificate issued by Ortho Specialist, District Hospital Durg that the writ petitioner is suffering from post polio residual paralysis. Accordingly, he needs the quarter to be retained so that while staying at Durg he would have opportunity to stay and to receive necessary treatment. The children of the writ petitioner are also staying there. It is submitted that without giving any opportunity of being heard the petitioner is sought to be evicted from the quarter allotted to him earlier at Durg. It appears that his contention is not sustainable inasmuch as he has already joined at another place of posting. Sooner or later he has to vacate the quarter allotted to him earlier at Durg. In this view of the matter, this Court is not inclined to interfere with the proposed action of the competent authority. However, in view of the physical disability</p>
