ORAL JUDGEMENT

#. The learned counsel Mr.N.A.Pandya, for the petitioner submitted that the dispute as regards the dues of respondent no.2 has already been settled outside the Court. It is further submitted that as for the

respondent nos.1 and 3 the petitioner has, by written instruction, a copy of which is placed on record, agreed to make payment of the total amount due as per the impugned award of the Labour Court. Therefore, the grievance made in the petition does not survive. The learned counsel appearing for respondent no.1 submitted that the amount lying deposited in the Court in respect of the claim of respondent nos.1 and 3 totaling to Rs.17,704.48ps deposited on 19.12.1988, is required to be disbursed in proportion of the amount due to each of the respondents alongwith interest accrued thereon.

#. Accordingly, the petition is disposed as withdrawn with the direction that the respondent nos.1 and 3 shall be paid the due and deposited amount of Rs.10,596.30ps and Rs.7,108.18ps respectively alongwith the interest accrued thereon so far, subject to the amount withdrawn, if any, by the respective respondents. With this direction to the office, the petition stands disposed and ruled is discharged with no order as to costs.
