ORAL JUDGEMENT

#. Heard the learned advocates.

#. The petitioners before this Court are the members of the Agricultural Produce Market Committee, Mandvi, District Kachchha. The term of the Market Committee has expired on 28th June, 2000. The election programme was also declared. However, the Government, under its Notification dated 10th July 2001, ordered the election programme to be kept in abeyance and directed appointment of an Administrator. Feeling aggrieved, the petitioners have preferred the present petition.

#. Pending this petition, the Director, Agricultural Produce and Rural Finance has, on 29th October 2001, issued order to proceed further with the election. The election programme has been set out. The scheduled date for election is 10th November, 2001. Copy of the said order is ordered to be taken on record. In view of the said order, the cause of action shall not survive. The petition is accordingly dismissed. It is, however, directed that the result of the election shall be declared forthwith and necessary notification shall be issued and published within two months therefrom. Subject to the above directions, rule is discharged. The parties shall bear their own costs.
