ORAL JUDGEMENT

- 2. This petition has been filed for a direction to the respondent to issue passport urgently under "Tatkal Scheme." It is stated by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has already made an application on 13-9-2001 before the respondent to issue passport urgently under the aforesaid scheme.
