This Writ Petition has been filed seeking for issuance of writ of mandamus directing the respondents to grant appropriate permission and necessary police protection for the initial preparation and kodai festival of Arulmighu Shri Mutharaman Thirukovil situated at Vadavilai, Kottar Post, Nagercoil, Kanyakumari District on 08.12.2018 to 12.12.2018 and on 21.12.2018 for conducting village meeting by taking into consideration the representation of the petitioner dated 05.11.2018.

The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner has been conducting annual Koodai festival and that initial preparation for white washing and putting pandhal has to be commenced from 08.12.2018 and that they have sent a representation to the respondents on 05.11.2018.
