Heard learned counsel for the revisionists.

I have perused the order passed by the Magistrate under Section 156 (3) of the Criminal Procedure Code. The order does not suffer from any error of law as the Magistrate has directed only for investigation in the matter. But the opinion of Magistrate that prima facie case is made out is not justified at this stage.

However, it is made clear that the order impugned in this revision dated 17.4.2001 passed by A.C.J.M. Kashipur, District-Udham Singh Nagar in Court case No.6 of 2001, State Versus Salim Uddin & others, under Secs.498-A, 323, 504 & 506 of the I.P.C. and Sec.3/4 of Dowry Prohibition Act, P.S.-Kashipur shall not effect in any manner the investigation.

Subject to above, the revision is dismissed.
