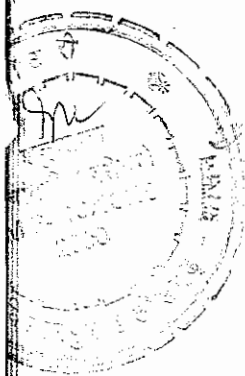

	<p><u>29-10-2002</u></p> <p>Shri Sanjay Kumar Agrawal, counsel for the petitioner.</p> <p>Heard.</p> <p>The grievance of the petitioner is to the action of the respondent in disconnecting the water and power supply to his residence namely C - 63, Urga Nagar, Gevra Area. The petitioner was a pathologist attached to the S.E.C.L. Gevra Hospital. By orders of the competent authority, he was also required to look after the Department of Pathology at Kusmunda. He is, however, residing at Gevra. On being posted at Kusmunda, he had given an application to the General Manager for permitting him to retain the quarters at Gevra, of which he is in occupation. According to the petitioner, his wife is also self-employed at Gevra. He has made a request for continuing there. Annexure P - 6 is a copy of his application to the Chief General Manager. It is the case of the petitioner that on his application, an endorsement was made by the Chief General Manager that the petitioner should be allowed to retain the quarter until further orders.
