Advocate for the respondents.</p> <p>The petitioner has in this petition sought for quashing of the order dated 1.6.2001 passed by respondent No.3 in case of <u>S.P.Manikpuri and others Vs. Ansuya Bai</u> and direct respondent No.2 to take decision on the appeal filed by the petitioner namely case No.10/B 121/2000-2001 within a stipulated time and also to consider the application for stay filed by the petitioner.</p> <p>It is submitted that against the order dated 1.6.2001 passed by the respondent No.3, the petitioner filed an appeal before the second respondent and the appeal is still pending. Along with the appeal, it is submitted that the petitioner has also filed an application for stay of the order-dated 1.6.2001 passed by respondent No.3. The grievance of the petitioner in this petition is that the petitioner filed an application for stay of the impugned order Annexure P-1 passed by respondent No.3 on 1.6.2001, the appellate Court has not considered and has not passed any order.</p>
