Koshy, Government Advocate, for respondents.</p> <p>By this writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of Constitution of India, petitioner prays for reinstatement of his service.</p> <p>This petition has been filed in the High Court and not before the Registry of State Administrative Tribunal where the matter is to be adjudicated.</p> <p>Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a direction be issued to the State Administrative Tribunal to decide the matter within 3 months. The State Administrative Tribunal is not a party here in the present writ petition. Normally this Court would have directed expediting the hearing, but where there is a list pending before the Authority, such direction cannot be issued. is not warranted.</p> <p>The course <del>is</del> open to the petitioner is to file the petition before the appropriate Tribunal and make a request for early hearing.
