Apart from challenging his termination, the petitioner also raised grievance against the inaction on the part of the Department in not taking a decision on his representation dated 30-10-2001.

The facts in brief are that, on the death of his father, the petitioner was given compassionate appointment in the year 1997. Subsequently on 06-06-1998, his services were terminated in view of the orders of the General Administrative Department of Government of Madhya Pradesh, whereby a decision was taken that the services of all persons appointed on daily wage basis after 31-12-1988 should be discontinued.

According to the petitioner, subsequent thereto, an order was issued on 17-05-2000 that the services of all those persons who are given compassionate appointments after 31-12-1988, be
