	23-9-2002 Shri Vishnu Kosta, counsel for the petitioner. Heard. The petitioner is working as Junior Engineer under the Chhattisgarh Electricity Board. The grievance of the writ petitioner is to the inaction of the authorities in not considering his case in terms of Circular No.01-05/F/125/Jabalpur, dated 18-6-1990. According to the petitioner, he has been working in rural areas from 26-5-1992 and his claim for posting to a urban area in terms of the Clause 11 of the said circular has not been considered though he has been sending repeated representations to the authorities. Copy of the representations dt. 03-05-1993, 10-2-1995, 25-07-1995, 27-6-2002 & 9-07-2002 are Annexures P-7, P-8, P-9, P-14 & P-15 to the writ petition. Further grievance of the petitioner is that instead of considering his representations favorably in terms of the Clause 11 of the said circular, the petitioner has, on the contrary, vide order dated 26-6-2002 (Annexure P-13) again been transferred from rural area Sarona, Distribution Centre to 132 KV Sub-station, Kirandal, which	

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Roshan	is also a rural area. Aggrieved therewith the petitioner has approached this Court for relief. Considering the grievance of the petitioner and the fact that the representations have not been considered, no useful purpose would be served in keeping this writ petition pending as the same can be disposed of at this stage by issuing direction to the authorities. Accordingly, the petition is disposed of by directing the authorities to consider the representation on its own merits and in accordance with guidelines governing the field. Needless to say that the representation should be considered as early as possible preferably within eight weeks from the date of receipt / production of the order.
