General for the State.</p> <p>Heard.</p> <p>In view of the limited nature of prayer made, no useful purpose would be served in keeping this writ petition pending, as the same can be disposed of at the admission stage.</p> <p>Admittedly, the petitioner was in custody in Central Jail, Bilaspur from 14-5-1987 to 18-12-2000. His grievance is that though for the said period he was entitled for payment of Rs.5,520/- as wages for the work done but he was not paid the entire amount and only a paltry sum of Rs.376/- was paid. Aggrieved with the inaction, the petitioner had submitted a representation to the Superintendent of Police, Central Jail, Bilaspur, which having not been considered, the petitioner has approached this Court for relief.</p> <p>Considering the nature of the averments, this writ petition is disposed of by directing the respondent No.2- Inspector General of Police (Jail), Police Headquarters, Raipur, to look into the grievance</p>
