

	for respondents No.1 to 3 submitted that after reconsidering the
	matter, the authorities have taken a decision to issue a fresh
	tender and if in response thereto the petitioner submits his
	tender, the same shall be considered on merits alongwith all
	other eligible offers that may be found in order. In this view of
	the matter, the Court feels that no useful purpose will be served
	in keeping this writ petition, as the grievance of the petitioner no
	longer survives. Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of
	with a direction that steps may be taken by respondents No.1, 2
	and 3 to issue fresh tender preferably within 4 weeks from today
	and in case the petitioner submits his tender, that be considered
	on its own merits alongwith all tenders submitted by other
	eligible persons who may also fulfil the conditions.
	With the aforesaid observation and direction, the petition stands disposed of.
