# ORAL JUDGEMENT

Learned Assistant Government Pleader places on record an order of the Industries Commissioner, dated 3.12.'96, which shows that the petitioner who was working

as Junior Industries Inspector had resigned with effect from 30th September, 1996 and that resignation was accepted with effect from 30th September, 1996. In this view of the matter, the present petition in which the petitioner has challenged the order of his termination, which was stayed, has become infructuous. The petition is, therefore, disposed of as having become infructuous since the petitioner has resigned from 30th September, 1996, which fact is placed on record by the learned Assistant Government Pleader. Rule is, therefore, discharged with no order as to costs. Interim relief stands vacated. Liberty to move in case of any difficulty.
