2. By this application the applicant State of  
Goa, is seeking to deposit the decretal amount of  
Rs.14,71,800/- (rupees fourteen lakhs seventy one  
thousand and eight hundred only), in this Court. The  
learned counsel for the respondent also has no objection  
to this amount being invested. The Additional Registrar  
to invest the amount in a Fixed Deposit in any

nationalized Bank, initially for a period three years and to be renewed thereafter from time-to time.
