- 2. Heard learned Government Advocate for the petitioners. The short relief sought in this Civil Revision Application is to set aside the Order dated 21st September, 2002 read with Order dated 16th September, 2002, passed by the learned Additional Registrar.
- 3. Perused the application. For the reasons stated therein sufficient cause is made out for setting aside the same. Under these circumstances, the Civil Revision Application is made absolute in terms of prayer Clause (a).
