ORAL JUDGMENT

Rule made returnable forthwith.

2. Heard learned Government Advocate for the petitioners. The short relief sought in this Civil Revision Application is to set aside the Order dated 21st September, 2002 read with Order dated 16th September, 2002, passed by the learned Additional Registrar.

3. Perused the application. For the reasons stated therein sufficient cause is made out for setting aside the same. Under these circumstances, the Civil Revision Application is made absolute in terms of prayer Clause (a). It is made clear that the petitioners shall comply with the requisition within a period of four weeks from today, failing which the Order passed by the learned Additional Registrar dated 21st September, 2002 read with Order dated 16th September, 2002, shall stand revived without any further reference to the Court.
