## ORAL JUDGMENT:

Rule. Rule made returnable forthwith.

- 2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned counsel for the Respondents No.2 to 6. Also heard the learned P.P. for the Respondent No.1.
- 3. The only submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner is that the proceeding which is pending under the provisions of Section 145 of Cr.P.C. before the concerned authority should be expedited. In fact, in the petition the prayer is made to issue directions to pass an order under Section 200 Cr.P.C. to appoint a Receiver of the property in the suit and for further direction to file F.I.R. for the alleged impugned offence. However, since the proceeding under Section 145 Cr.P.C. is pending, it would not be proper to issue directions as prayed for in the petition itself.
- 4. Hence by consent of the parties, it is hereby directed that the said competent authority shall hear and adjudicate the proceeding under Section 145 Cr.P.C. pending before it expeditiously and dispose it off according to law as early as possible.

5. With these directions the petition stands disposed of.
