

**THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE A.RAJASHEKER REDDY**

**C.R.P.NO.45 OF 2022**

**O R D E R**

Aggrieved by the non-disposal of I.A.No.1146 of 2019 in O.S.No.1148 of 2018 on the file of XV Additional District and Sessions Judge at L.B. Nagar, Ranga Reddy District, the respondent No.21 / defendant No.21 in the said application, filed the present revision petition.

2. Sri E.Madan Mohan Rao, learned Senior Counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the trial court has granted *ex parte ad interim* injunction on 02.07.2019 restraining the respondents from in any way alienating the application schedule properties, and though the petitioner herein has filed counter affidavit, the court below is not taking up the Interlocutory Application for disposal, and is extending the ad interim injunction order from time to time. He submits that as per Order 39, Rule 3-A the court below has to dispose of the application, where it has granted injunction without notice to opposite party, within a period of thirty days from the date on which the injunction was granted, or else it has to record reasons for such inability to dispose of the application. He submits that the counter affidavit is filed and pleadings are complete, but the trial court is not taking up the application for disposal, and the petitioner is put to severe hardship.

3. Since the prayer of the petitioner in this revision is innocuous i.e., seeking for only early disposal of the Interlocutory Application filed during the year 2019 and where *ex parte ad interim* injunction was granted, this court is of the view that no notice is required to be issued to the respondents for disposal of the revision.

4. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, and without expressing any opinion on merits, and also having regard to the pandemic which affected the functioning of the courts, the revision petition is disposed of at the stage of admission directing the trial court to dispose of I.A.No.1146 of 2019 in

O.S.No.1448 of 2018, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5. Interlocutory applications pending, if any, shall stand closed. No order as to costs.
