In all fairness to him, the  
learned counsel for the  
petitioner makes statement that  
the petitioner may be granted  
one year time to vacate the  
disputed premises.

Considering the facts and  
circumstances of the case,  
prayer deserves to be allowed.  
One year's time as prayed is  
granted to the petitioner to  
vacate the disputed premises.  
The petitioner shall hand over  
the possession of the disputed  
premises to the landlord  
/respondent No.3 after the  
expiry of period of one year  
from today, failing it is open  
for the landlord/respondent  
No.3 to take over the  
possession forcibly.

Subject to above  
direction, the writ petition is  
disposed of finally.
