1, 25,8,2003	We have heard Mr. D. K. Singh, learned Counsel for the petitioner and Mr. J. B. Pradhan, learned Government Advocate assisted by Mr. Karma Thinlay, learned Assistant Government Advocate for the opposite parties – respondents. Grievance of the petitioner in this writ petition is that, although the FIR at Annexure P/2 was filed before the Officer-in-Charge, Sadar Police Station, Gangtok on 9.8.2003 making out a case under Section 153-A IPC., the Officer-in-Charge has not taken note of it. This grievance of the petitioner can be looked into/examined if the petitioner or the informant would bring the same to the notice of the concerned Superintendent of Police as provided under sub-Section 3 of Section 154 of the Cr.P.C. Under the circumstances, learned Counsel for the petitioner sought permission to withdraw the writ petition to pursue the alternative remedy available under the above provisions. Considering the facts and circumstances, we permit him to withdraw this writ petition with liberty to approach the appropriate authority for necessary relicf.
