Advocate General submitted that an alternative plot measuring 25'x15'= 375 sft at Singtam has been proposed to be given to the petitioner vide letter No.9026 dated 18-10-2003 of the U.D. & H. Department of the State Govt. A copy of the said Govt. order is produced before us for our perusal which may be kept on record. The same will form a part of this order. Shri Sharma, learned counsel for the petitioner says that by the present offer a reduced area is being made and the exact location of the site is also not indicated in the Govt. order. The petitioner may get the position clerified from the concerned department. In the circumstances in view of such an offer made on behalf of the State Government, the petitioner is permitted to withdraw this writ petition with liberty to approach this Court again if he latter feels aggrieved.

The writ petition is accordingly disposed of.
