In view of the limited nature of prayer made at the time of hearing which is for a direction to the appropriate authority to take a decision on the petitioner's representation, copy where is Annexure P-10 to the writ petition, no useful purpose would be served in keeping this writ petition as the same can be disposed of at this stage.

It is the case of the petitioner that he was a daily wage employee appointed against a vacant and regular post of 'shoemaker' in the District Rehabilitation Centre. According to him, he being a member of the Scheduled Caste was entitled to be regularized against the regular post in terms of the notification dated 27-07-1996. But ignoring the said notification, his case has not been considered. A representation (Annexure P-10) was also submitted to the respondent No.3- Joint Director, Panchayat & Social Service, Bilaspur Division, Bilaspur, which

having not been considered, he has approached this Court for relief.

Since the representation is admittedly pending, this writ petition is disposed of by directing the said respondent No.3 or any such other competent authority to consider the petitioner's representation and take an appropriate decision thereon on its own merits, within a period of four weeks from the date of communication/ receipt of this order. It is made clear that this Court is not expressing any opinion on the merits of the petitioner's case and that representation will have to be decided by the concerned authority on its own merits.

Consequently M.W.P. No.564/2002 for interim relief & I.A. No.4467/2002 for urgent hearing also stand disposed of.
