Though this matter was listed for admission, considering the short point involved in this writ petition, on the prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner and with the consent of the State counsel, it is being disposed of at the admission stage.

Heard.

The case of the petitioners is that they are the legal heirs of late Smt. Ganga Devi who had purchased the land in question on 14.3.1967 with permission of the Collector, Ambikapur, which was granted in Revenue Case No. 49-A/21 of 1965-66. Ignoring all this, the petitioners assert, the owner of the land in question has filed an application under Section 170 (B) before respondent No.2 who has allowed the application and directed that property be restored to the original owner.

According to the petitioners, against the order of S.D.O. an appeal was preferred by the petitioners before the Collector,

Surguja alongwith an application of stay. However, though the appeal has been entertained, the stay application has been rejected which order is the subject matter of challenged in this writ petition.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioners that since the appeal has been admitted, under the facts and circumstances of the case, the respondent No.1 was not justified in rejecting the application as dispossession and restoration of the property to the original owner will virtually make the appeal infructuous.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the State, the Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose would be served in keeping the writ petit on pending as the same can be disposed of by granting interim protection to the petitioners which the Court considers, on the facts and circumstances of the case, to be appropriate. Accordingly, the order refusing stay passed by respondent No 1-Collector, Ambikapur in Appeal No.11/A-23/2002-03 is set aside and it is directed that the operation of the order dated 29.11.2002 (Annexure P/1) passed by Sub-Divisional Officer Surajpur in Revenue Case
