Indira Tripathi, counsel for the petitioner.</p> <p>Heard.</p> <p>By this petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India the petitioner seeks that the respondents may kindly be directed to consider the case of the petitioner for transferring her at Bhilai. The petitioner further seeks a direction to the respondents to extend the attachment period of the petitioner for further period of six months or till her delivery whichever is earlier on the humanitarian ground.</p> <p>The petitioner is working as Clerk-cum-Cashier in the State of Indore since 1995 and posted at Damoh and on her request and medical ground she was attached with the State Bank of Indore, branch at Bhilai for two months.</p> <p>It is contended on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is permanent resident of Bhilai and her parents are also residents of Bhilai and the petitioner has one mentally retarded sister and her father died on 28th March, 2003. The petitioner was married in the year 1990 and her husband is also residing at Bhilai and the petitioner is presently pregnant by two and half months, therefore, in view of the above situation respondents may be directed to transfer the petitioner at Bhilai or her attachment with the Bhilai branch may be extended for another six months or till her delivery whichever is earlier.</p>

	<p>No employee has a right to seek his/her transfer as per his/her place of choice. It is for the employer to post or transfer the employee as per the policy and as the exigency of work requires and in Public Interest. The petitioner was attached with the Bhilai branch looking to her difficulty, she has no right to continue in that branch office. Therefore, this petition is totally misconceived. However, it is for the respondents to consider her representation if they found that the petitioner could be posted at Bhilai or her attachment can be extended. It is within their power to decide the representation of the petitioner considering all the aspects.</p> <p>With the observations, this petition is disposed of. Consequently, M.W.P.No.1684/2003 for interim relief and I.A.No.5586/2003 for urgent hearing also stand disposed of.</p>	<p>Sd/- L.C.BHADOO Judge</p>
