

By this writ petition under Article 226 / 227 of Constitution of India the petitioner has challenged the order dated 25.08.2003 by which the petitioner who is working as Assistant Teacher in Government Girls Middle School, Ramanujnagar has been transferred from Ramanujnagar to Baikunthpur, Distt. Koriya.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is an Assistant Teacher and his seniority is maintained district-wise, therefore, the petitioner cannot be transferred out of the district.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the transfers which were made on administrative exigency the seniority is not affected.

Having heard the learned counsel for the parties and having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, I am of the opinion that if the petitioner is allowed to make a representation raising all his grievances and the same is decided by respondent no.2 that will meet the ends of justice. It is therefore, directed that
