	<p><u>30-08-2003</u></p> <p>Heard Shri Prashant Jayaswal, counsel for the petitioner.</p> <p>Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is not being allowed to join the duties as Secretary, Gram Panchayat, Pahanda, Korba and an enquiry was instituted against the petitioner in which he was exonerated vide Annexures- P/1 and P/2. Learned Counsel further submitted the Chief Executive Officer, Korba directed the Sarpanch, Gram Panchayat, Pahanda to take the petitioner on duty, but the Sarpanch is adamant and he is not taking the petitioner on duty. Learned counsel also submitted that the petitioner was also made a representation on 17-07-2003, but he has not been allowed to join the duties.</p> <p>Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner is allowed to make a fresh representation to respondent No.3 raising all his grievances within a period of 10 days and the respondent No.3 is directed to consider the representation of the petitioner in an objective manner and pass appropriate order considering the facts and circumstances of the case within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of the representation.</p> <p>With these observations, the writ petition stands disposed of.</p> <p>Consequently, M.W.P.No.2228/03 and I.A.No.7433/2003 stand disposed of.</p> <p>Parties are entitled for the certified copy of the order.</p>
