The petitioner was appointed on 07.02.1959 as 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Clerk and on that capacity he worked till 29.02.1980 under the Collectorate, Durg. From 01.03.1980, the petitioner was absorbed in the office of District & Sessions Judge, Durg in the same capacity. The petitioner was promoted in the post of Assistant Grade –II vide order-dated 02.05 1990 and till his retirement he worked on the same post.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner served more than 41 years and got only one promotion in his whole service carrier, whereas the petitioner is entitled for two promotions in his whole service carrier under the Time Bound Scheme issued by the then Government of Madhya Pradesh which is applicable in this State also. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that various representations were made by the petitioner but those representations have not been considered by
