By this writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has challenged the order dated 11.09.2003 passed by the Principal, Govt. Women Polytechnic College, Rajnandgaon, by which the petitioner has been asked to make alternative arrangement as on account of

The petitioner's case is that the petitioner was appointed as Assistant Grade-III and performing the work of Stenographer from 10th October, 1998, in the Govt. Women Polytechnic College, Rajnandgaon, Chhattisgarh and he was getting wages as per the daily wager fixed from time to time. The petitioner was also teaching the students enrolled and got admitted in the Women Polytechnic College, Rajnandgaon, for Hindi and English Stenography and typing. The petitioner possesses the professional Diploma in Hindi & English Stenography from the Government Polytechnic College, Durg and also having education qualification up to Master of Commerce (Previous). The petitioner was also getting the remuneration of Rs.20/- per period for imparting training to the students whenever special coaching was conducted for English/Hindi Stenography and he discharges his duties with utmost sincerity and loyalty and there was nothing adverse against him and all of a sudden without giving any opportunity of hearing, the petitioner has been served with a notice of

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termination (Annexure P-1) which is illegal, arbitrary, unjust and against the principles of natural justice.

Learned Govt. Advocate appearing on behalf of the State/respondents submits that the petitioner is a daily wager employee, therefore he can be removed at any time.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is serving regularly and he is being removed without any reason. She further submits that the petitioner may be allowed to make a representation to respondents raising all his grievance and respondents be directed to decide his representation after considering the material facts.

Having heard the learned counsel for the parties and having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner is allowed to make a detailed representation raising all his grievances within ten days from today to respondent No.2 and in turn, respondent No.2 shall decide the representation within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of the same in an objective manner with a reasoned order.

With the above observations and directions the petition stands disposed of.

In view of this order, M.(W.)P.No.3575/2003 and I.A. No.11390/2003 also stand disposed of.
