JUDGMENT

Kurian Joseph, J.

This appeal is filed against the order dated 8.1.2003 in I.A. No.1402/2002 in O.S. No.237/2002 on the file of the Sub Court, Palakkad whereby the court refused to continue the interim injunction and dismissed the petition. It is seen from the order that the court below has proceeded on the basis that the suit is one for injunction and that the plaintiffs have not filed any suit for partition. We are afraid that the court below has not properly adverted to the nature of the suit. It is seen from the plaint that the suit is one for partition simplicitor. Therefore, it is not necessary for this court at this stage to go into the various contentions taken by the appellant including the contention based on Section 90 of the Indian Trust Act since the matter, in our view, requires reconsideration.

Accordingly, we set aside the order under challenge and remit the matter to the court below for fresh consideration
