**The Court at the admission stage made the following ORDER:**

The grievance of the petitioner is that on 07.09.2004, the second respondent obtained illegal tap connection by connecting their line to the main pipe line without any authority. Though the petitioner gave complaint and got issued a legal notice dated 11.09.2004, the first respondent has not taken any action against the second respondent. Hence, he filed the present writ petition to direct the first respondent to take action against the second respondent.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Government Pleader for Metro Water Works.

Since Hyderabad Metro Water Supply & Sewerage Board is concerned with supply of the water to the public by giving connections, no relief, as prayed for, can be granted to the petitioner. However, I am of the view that the petitioner is at liberty to approach the authorities of Hyderabad Metro Water Supply & Sewerage Board and put forward his grievance.

The writ petition is dismissed.
