Heard Sri Arvind Kumar Vashistha, learned counsel for the applicants and Sri D.K. Sharma A.G.A.

The applicant is facing prosecution for the offence punishable under section 304B and 498 A I.P.C. and section  $\frac{3}{4}$  of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

The applicant is the brother-in-law of the deceased. The investigation is complete and the charge sheet has been filed. There is no probability to tamper with the evidence or witnesses.

I, therefore, direct that the applicant, namely, Raj Kumar be released on bail on his furnishing a personal bond with two sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of the C.J.M. Haridwar.
